I. Background and Methodology

The annual GALILEO survey is conducted to ascertain user satisfaction and usage habits regarding GALILEO resources. Annual surveys have been conducted since 1996, one year after the GALILEO initiative was put into production. For most years, the survey was administered via a link on the website in the fall, traditionally and optimal time for gathering information in K-12, public, and academic libraries. In 2009, the survey link appeared in the spotlight area of each user view except GALILEO Kids. For most users, GALILEO Kids is accessed through the K-12 default user view, which did include the survey link, so younger users were able to see the invitation when they first went to GALILEO. The 2009 survey was open from November 9–15, 2009. All surveys were gathered via the GALILEO website.

The survey included questions included in each year previous, as well as questions asked only in 2009 to measure satisfaction with specific features and technologies. Below is a summary of questions on the 2009 survey:

- Five statements rated by respondent on GALILEO performance and value (included each year)
- Five statements rated by respondent about new functions with space to comment (2009 survey)
- Open-ended question: "I would improve GALILEO by . . ." (included each year)
- Questions probing communication preferences and expectations for mobile optimization (2009 survey)
- Self-identifying and –describing questions about user and institution types, usage frequency, and where respondent learned about GALILEO (included each year)

Survey instrument (Appendix A)

ABOUT THE RESPONSES: There were 912 completed surveys after de-duplication, a 10% increase from last year's total (827).

User Types

Of the 824 respondents who self-identified, 510 were non-librarian user types. With the removal of librarians and media specialists, who represented 38% of the respondents, the largest number of responses came from users who identified themselves as undergraduate students (32%), followed by Faculty (18.4%). Undergraduates were at the top last year, and K-12 students were second.

Institution Types

The highest percentage of responses came from public K12 schools, whether media specialists were included (29.9%) or removed (27.4%). The next highest percentages came from four-year USG institutions (20.2%, 25.4%). The same groups were the highest responders last year.

II. Summary of Data

Rating Performance and Value

As in past years, survey respondents indicate a high level of satisfaction with GALILEO performance and value. For example, 95% agree or strongly agree that GALILEO is a valuable service and 83.9% agree or strongly agree they found it easy to use GALILEO. In years up to 2009, a four-element forced-choice Likert scale was used; in 2009 the scale was updated to

include a neutral choice. Results were counted for all respondents and separately for all respondents minus librarians and media specialists. The intention for this grouping of data was to be sure end user responses were measured apart from librarians and media specialists, but in fact, the percentages changed very little (< 6% change) in the top chosen categories for each statement whether the librarians and media specialists were included or not. In the narrative below, percentages refer to all respondents.

Rating New Tools and Features

An additional question on the 2009 survey asked respondents to rate their satisfaction with recently- implemented tools and features, such as the GALILEO Toolbar and Journals A-Z, with a follow-up open-ended question asking for comments about the tools. Again, the satisfaction ratings were high. Journals A-Z as a tool for streamlining access to journal and magazine content was rated agree or strongly agree by 79.2%. GALILEO Search as a way to retrieve satisfactory results was rated agree or strongly agree by 73.5%. although many users have not discovered the video tutorials (33%) or downloaded the GALILEO Toolbar (30%).

The open-ended question asking for comments or questions about the tools mentioned was answered by 150 (16.4%) of respondents. Of these, 13.3% (20) noted that the respondent was not aware of some or all the tools. Comments varied from rave reviews of tools ("I adore the journal search; it saves so much time if I have an article in mind and am searching for it") to reports of issues encountered ("GALILEO Search takes too long for our servers—it times us out"). Some users from public K-12 schools (8, or 5.3%) reported local technical or policy issues with downloading the GALILEO Toolbar.

"Improve" Narrative

Of the 912 respondents to the 2009 survey, 587, or 64.4%, took the time to offer narrative comments to the "I would improve GALILEO by . . ." question that is asked on the annual survey each year. Of the 587 comments, 14.4% (83) were positive and 4.09% (24) were mixed with positive and negative elements. Some representative positive comments are below.

- "I actually enjoy using GALILEO when finding resources for all my literature papers. I think that the content is very easy to navigate and use. I do not have any complaints."
- "As an educator, I really like GALILEO and encourage our students to use it. I think for some students it can be overwhelming, so I engage them with one database and then, once they are comfortable with that introduce them to others. GALILEO is a great time saving device and provides students with scholarly information."
- "I find that GALILEO meets the information needs of our students after they learn how to use the many, many databases available."
- "I really don't know how you could better GALILEO. GALILEO is very simple and easy to understand. I believe a first time computer user could easily navigate through the different tabs and such that GALILEO has. It has plenty of information that one would need to complete a project, essay, etc."
- "Continue to enhance the student areas with more sites for them to search for information. (Thanks for the improvements that were made last year. They're great!)"
- "i thnk galileo iz vry uzefol b/c i uze it at mi houze!! galileo iz a gret wbste 2 uze evn if u r at school!!"

While the positive narrative responses and the high ranking users gave to GALILEO in other parts of the survey show an overall satisfaction with GALILEO, this question asks users to offer opinions about shortcomings or areas that need improvement, so it is understandable that the number of responses coded as negative or neutral are higher than the number of strictly positive responses. Suggestions made in response to this question are valuable sources for informing

modifications and future development of GALILEO and have been referred to the change review process.

Over one third of the comments (37%) related to a suggestion to add content, either by general suggestions for more databases (18%) or for specific subject areas or products (11%). Many comments (10.7%) concerned the interfaces, which still have a new feel having been implemented in March 2008, referring to the look and feel ("I would like a search box on the first screen"), to the organization and navigation ("I have some trouble navigating the site and finding the resources I need"), and to anticipated updates ("I look forward to the new interface for elementary level users"). A few comments (18, or 3.1%) referred to searchability challenges and performance issues with the federated search product that powers GALILEO Search, WebFeat, including problems encountered with server errors and other error messages. Performance issues have been reported to the vendor, and most have been resolved since the survey responses were collected.

Some comments reflected expectations that have been molded by users' experiences with the Web, such as optimization for mobile formats and "Did you mean?" suggestions for spell checking and search term refinement. Customization options, such as persistent folders and customized search sets created by individual users, were also suggested ("I would love it if I could sign in to GALILEO and have my favorite database pop up first").

Preferred Information Channels

The survey also included a question on preferred information channels (e-mail, RSS, and social networking sites). Over half of the respondents preferred to receive information through e-mail (59.5%). The second preferred choice was Facebook at 17.5%. Twitter received the most votes for "Will not use and would waste valuable resources to maintain."

Mobile Optimization

A final question addressed the desirability of mobile optimization. The majority of respondents (59%) are not currently using mobile devices for research; however, a much smaller number (31%) answered that they disagree or strongly disagree to the desirability of searching GALILEO databases with their mobile devices. User expectations for a mobile interface and search tool may evolve quickly. The follow up question, "What are some things would you like to do on GALILEO using your mobile device," was addressed by 252 (27.6%) of the respondents. Of these, 91 (36.1%) responded that they didn't have mobile devices, or didn't subscribe to Internet service on their mobile devices, or that they wouldn't use them for research. More than half of the respondents who answered the question (143, or 56.7%) described ways they would use their mobile device for research. Below are sample responses.

- Search for the authors of articles, get brief summaries of articles so that I can decide if it is worth looking more in depth into for a project or paper
- Search and use newspapers and magazines while waiting.
- Research while studying for tests
- Consumer Reports research when shopping.
- Mobile devices would be good if someone wanted to receive a RSS feed on a saved search for current awareness or tables of contents of newly published journal literature
- I could look up certain scraps of information that I wouldn't want to pull out my laptop to look up. I could also send a piece of information over to a friend if they are having trouble finding something themselves
- Find articles needed for homework. I have elementary and middle school children who are busy with after-school activities. It would be wonderful to have them to do their

research while waiting for their siblings at soccer/baseball practice instead of when we get home.

- E-mail result back to myself for later reference or printing from another computer.
- show videos like tornado of 36 and MLK speeches


Conclusion




