Using Absurdities to Make Your Point





Reductio ad Absurdum

Latin for "Reduction to Absurdity"

Characterizing an argument to its absurdities.



Presenting an argument in a way that it appears to go against all tenets of logic



The counterargument might be so silly that no reasonable person would take that position.



Example of Reduction and absurdum

You are in trouble for skipping school, but you tell your father, "All of my friends were going!"

He says, "Well, if all of your friends were going to jump off of a bridge, would you do that, too?"

Appeal to Extremes


If someone says "X", then you respond with the ultimate extreme opposite

Example:

X=Girl Scouts sold \$500 worth of cookies in an hour

Y=They couldn't have sold \$500 in a hour, because in an 8 hr day that's the equivalent of over \$1 million in a year




What Just Happened?








Abel noted that people had been either outraged by the idea of SINA, or quite supportive of it. One woman in Santa Barbara reportedly tried to donate \$40,000 to the cause. Tagline: A nude horse is a rude horse.




