Expanding Access to Digital Resources

- Community of Library Professionals Contributing to eResources Group
- GPLS partnership with Palace App
- Investment in significant statewide shared collection of content for all ages
- Offering the service for free to all GA library systems
- Libraries contributing to shared collection



Statewide Adoption Updates

- 59 library systems are now live in Georgia
- Usage details
 - Over 26,000 checkouts in 2025
 - 63% of checkouts are audiobooks
 - More than 3,300 new patrons used the app in 2025
 - eRead Kids content checkout increases
- Promotional efforts
- Growing collections
- Increased interest

New Statewide Collections

- Indie Author Project Select
 - BiblioBoard, perpetual/sim use: **1,191 new titles**
- Children's & YA Graphic Novels
 - BiblioBoard, perpetual/sim use: **263 new titles**

- Top GADD holds
 - Palace Marketplace, trad. licensing: 70 unique titles, 285 copies



GPLS Shared Collection: eRead Kids Baker & Taylor

- Approximately 45,000 copies of titles in the collection
- Curated by Evan Bush from GPLS & a team of Georgia children's libraries
- Content is provided by Baker & Taylor Boundless
- Collection includes titles for kids
- Fiction and nonfiction materials





GPLS Shared Collection: eRead Georgia Palace Marketplace




- 9,726 titles including 6,040 ebooks and 3,686 audiobooks
- Collection curated by participating Georgia libraries
- Content provided by Palace
 Marketplace
- Collection focused on popular ebook and audiobook titles
- Curated lists and lanes created to highlight featured content



GPLS Shared Collections: BiblioBoard

- 3,381 BiblioBoard perpetual access, simultaneous use ebooks
- Multilingual children's content collection
- Curated by Evan Bush from GPLS & a team of Georgia children's librarians
- Content available in 29 languages
- Includes 263 digital comics from publishers such as Archie Comics and Boom Studios





GPLS Shared Collections: ProQuest

- Approximately 160,000 ProQuest ebooks
- Not a specifically "curated" collection
- Academic-focused titles with some leisure reading available





GPLS Shared Collections: Palace Bookshelf


- 29,000+ open access and public domain titles
- Configured as part of the collection for all participating libraries
- Includes open textbooks, public domain titles and popular classics, and open access materials

Historical Circulation



 Chart reflects usage from 6/14/24 -6/2/25






Usage: Checkouts by Distributor
