OER = Education + Free + Permissions


- Any educational resources where the content is available in open access in some form
- Plus the permission to:
 - Revise
 - Remix
 - Redistribute
 - Reuse
 - Retain
- Permissions (usually) through Creative Commons licenses

Core ALG Strategies


- Provide incentives to redesign courses to use free and low-cost materials
 - Includes creation of new high-quality materials where OER do not currently exist
- Build an engaged community of educators
- Involve each library and faculty members: Champions and Coordinators at each institution

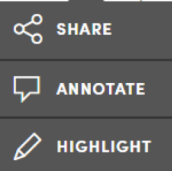
- One of the first two UNG Press Partner Texts: between one grant team and the Press

The Future of ALG
