





What do I need to know?

- What is the material?
 - ► There are 15,000 copies of ebooks and eAudio titles, which are in varying license formats, both metered and perpetual.
- How do I access the material?
 - ► The titles can be accessed via a web browser or the Axis 360 mobile app.
 - ▶ The user will login with their library card.
 - ► The user can browse by subject or search by title, author, ISBN or keywords.







- How do I let users know about this collection?
 - ► GPLS has partnered with Baker & Taylor to provide customized digital marketing assets to both libraries and schools. There will be an assortment of files for both digital use and print.
 - ▶ Baker & Taylor will also provide printed posters to be distributed to all of the GPLS branches throughout the state.
 - Links to content will be also be provided through the GPLS site.
- Where do I go to access help for staff or users?
 - An FAQ document, videos, help site and an online ticket system will be provided if you cannot answer the initial inquiry.







Getting Kids to the Content?

- If you are a Public Library?
 - Advertise this collection as part of your regular program of events.
 - Use social media platforms or mailing list to get the word out.
- If you are a school?
 - Partner with your local public library to assist parents and students with getting a library card. Students will need a library card to access the content so it is important that you help usher that relationship with the library.
