IN COPYRIGHT










#### Avoid unintentional (or not) copyfraud

None. In the public domain due to failure to comply with required formalities



- Often well meaning (not always) but incorrect claims about copyright
- Confusion about what is or is not covered by copyright
- Blanket statements
- U.S. vs international rules
- Asserting rights when there is none OR making it more open than rights allow




