



DH Sandbox Experience **Preserving and Digitizing GGC History**



This project involves the preservation of college publications in General Space, GGC's Institutional Repository, with the intention of mining them for key historical events of the institution. Starting with The Globe student newspaper, two GGC librarians located, inventoried, OCRed, digitized, applied metadata and uploaded files to the repository. Historical timeline software will be investigated and adopted to create an interactive version of GGC history.

Catherine Downey, Associate Professor and Head of Access Services and Information Commons, and **Amy Eklund**, Assistant Professor and Head of Collections, are librarians at Kaufman Library with experience in college archives, digital projects, and with liaison responsibilities for the School of Liberal Arts.





In 2005, while Perdua was governor of Georgia, he signed Senate Resolution 33 which allowed for the creation of GGC, the first new college in Georgia in over 100 years. Chancelor Perdue gave credit for GGC's creation the former Senator, Don Ballour, an advocate for the dwinnet community by identifying the need for a higher educational institution within Gwinnett county.
