Search Tips

- Census records can be rich with details about your ancestor. Be sure to look at each and every question that was asked and use the answers to locate more records. For example, the U.S. federal censuses for the years 1900-1930 include a date of immigration for immigrants. Use that date to narrow your search for your ancestor's passenger arrival record in the Immigration Collection.
- Pinpoint your ancestor's location from the census on a map, and then look for churches, cemeteries, and other places where your ancestor may have left records.

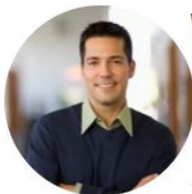

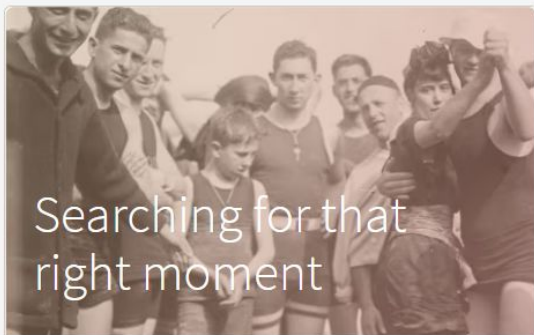

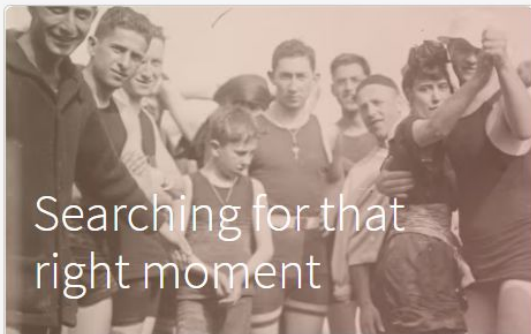

About U.S. City Directories, 1821-1989

This database is a collection of directories for U.S. cities and counties in various years. The database currently contains directories for all states except Alaska.

Generally a city directory will contain an alphabetical list of citizens, listing the names of the heads of households, their addresses, and occupational information. Sometimes a wife's name will be listed in parentheses or italics following the husband's. Other helpful information might include death dates for individuals who had been listed in the previous year's directory, names of partners in firms, and forwarding addresses or post offices for people who had moved to another town.

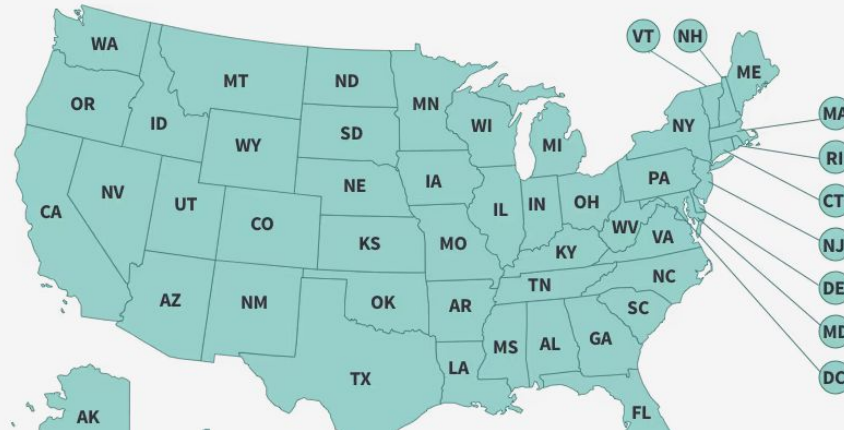

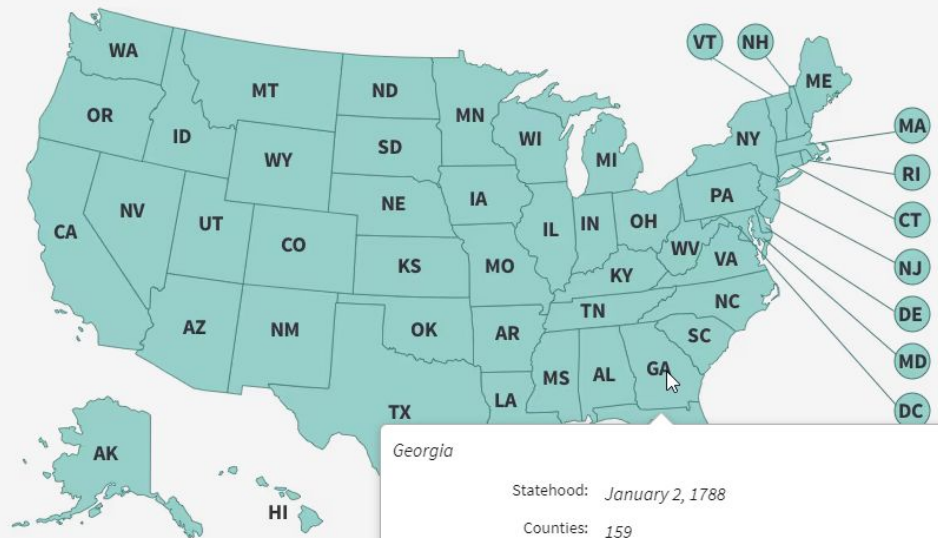

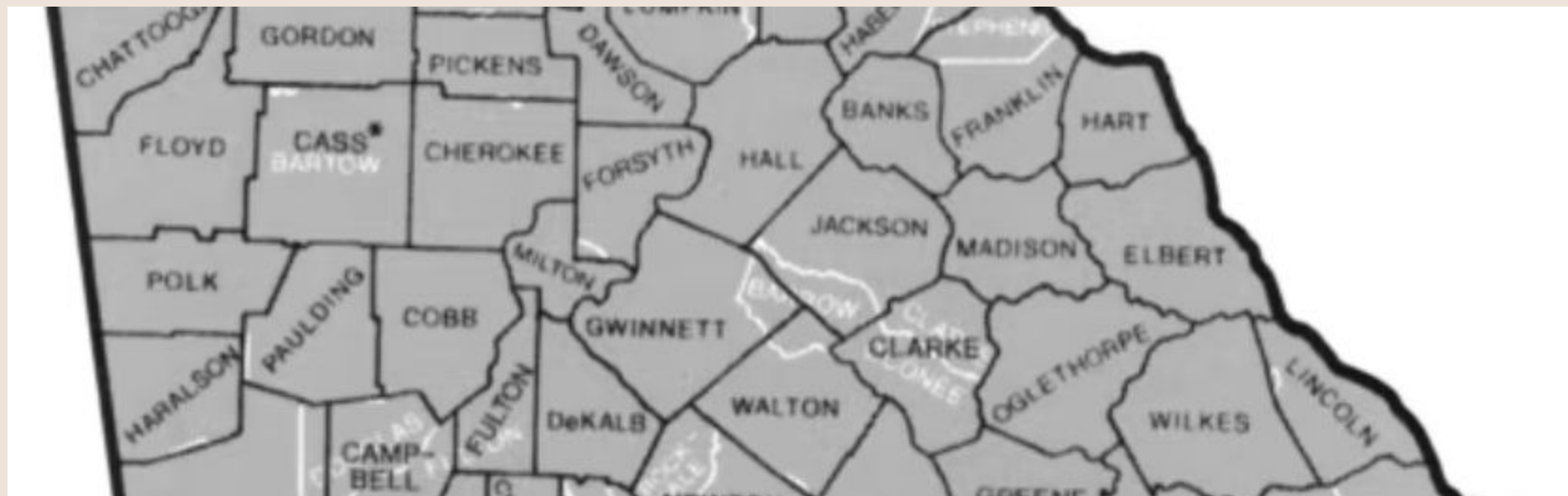

Family history research begins in modern times and works backwards, generation by generation. Discoveries for all American families, regardless of ethnicity, are made through census records, military papers, vital records (births, marriages, and deaths), and other documents created over a lifetime.

African American family history research, however, can pose unique challenges as you follow your family into the 19th century, just prior to the Civil War.

PART 1: Getting to 1870

Start in 1940

Your research starts with family members who are alive today. Listen to stories, ask questions, and jot down names, places, dates, and other details. Then use these details to search the 1940 U.S. Federal Census on Ancestry.com for someone in your family who was living in the U.S. in 1940. (If you're new to the site, you may be asked to input your name so the site can save your search information into a family tree and conduct behind-the-scenes searches for additional records for you.)

- Start your search with the 1940 U.S. Federal Census because it lists all 134 million people living in the United States on April 1, 1940, by name. Along with names, you'll learn things like occupation, address, education level, birthplace, and other people living in the house.
