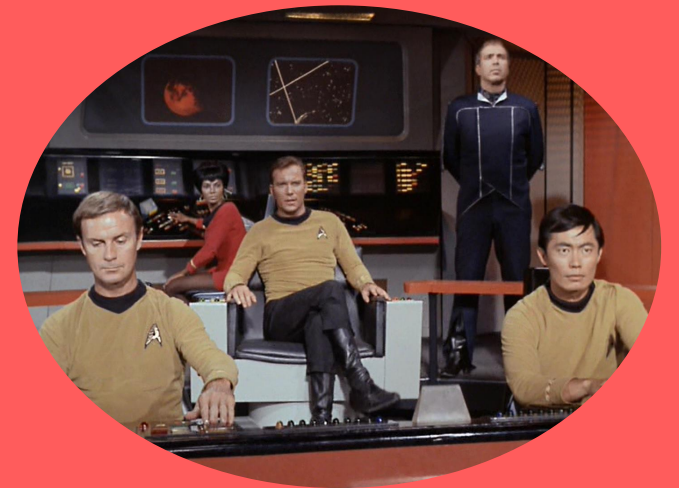
# What we did

- Using the EBSCO EDS API, a solution was developed to sort content by material type



# Why we did it

- One of the most common needs expressed for GALILEO development was improved search results!
- What Kirk says:  
“Finding a needle in a haystack would be child's play.”



# What's next?

- Bentos as embeddable search box
  - So if you wanted to add a “scholarly articles” or “ebook” search to a page, you could!
- Bento personalization
  - Turn bentos on/off as needed





# What you might have missed...

---

- When using the GALILEO portal, the search method will default to what was used last (bento/classic)
- There is a “Lexile Range” filter in the bento search
- We went back and made sure that the “Peer Reviewed Journals” limit only appears where...logical

# What we did

- Initially released A-Z list functionality that was less robust than previous
- After feedback, we improved that functionality



# Why we did it

- Initial feedback on the database search suggested that simplification was in order
- We had to make some changes to infrastructure that didn't support the old way of doing A-Z list and database searching
- After the initial release, user feedback made it clear that we needed to add functionality back to the A-Z list/database search



# What's next?

- We haven't heard many complaints since the relevance ranking was improved and we added the true A-Z list option
- This is an area where you may well have feedback!
- Mr. Spock says "...It is merely logical to try all the alternatives."

# Single Sign On/OpenAthens

# What we did

- Implemented a new authentication system for GALILEO called OpenAthens



# Why we did it

- Replaced aging IT infrastructure with a modern, more secure solution
- It is a relatively simple authentication solution that made single sign on available to all GALILEO libraries regardless of technical staffing or budget
- Improves discovery of content on the open web
- Provides infrastructure for deeper personalization of the GALILEO user experience
- Strategic Planning: “Make authentication as easy as possible”





# What's next?

- Explore best practices for user personalization
- Investigate the possibilities for personalized services
- Create the ability for users to access/store content in a vendor neutral environment
- Authentication “holy grail”

# What we did

- Completely revamped the backend of GALILEO, previously used for one or two services like GLRI, and made additional self-service options available to institutional GALILEO administrators



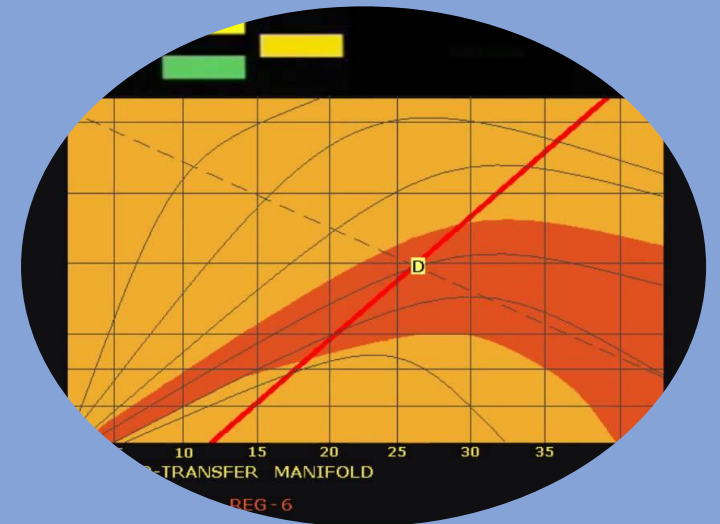
# Why we did it

- Infrastructure needed to be updated
- Provide more institutional control over the GALILEO experience
- Make it easier for both GALILEO staff and local administrators to maintain electronic resources in GALILEO

- Additional bento controls





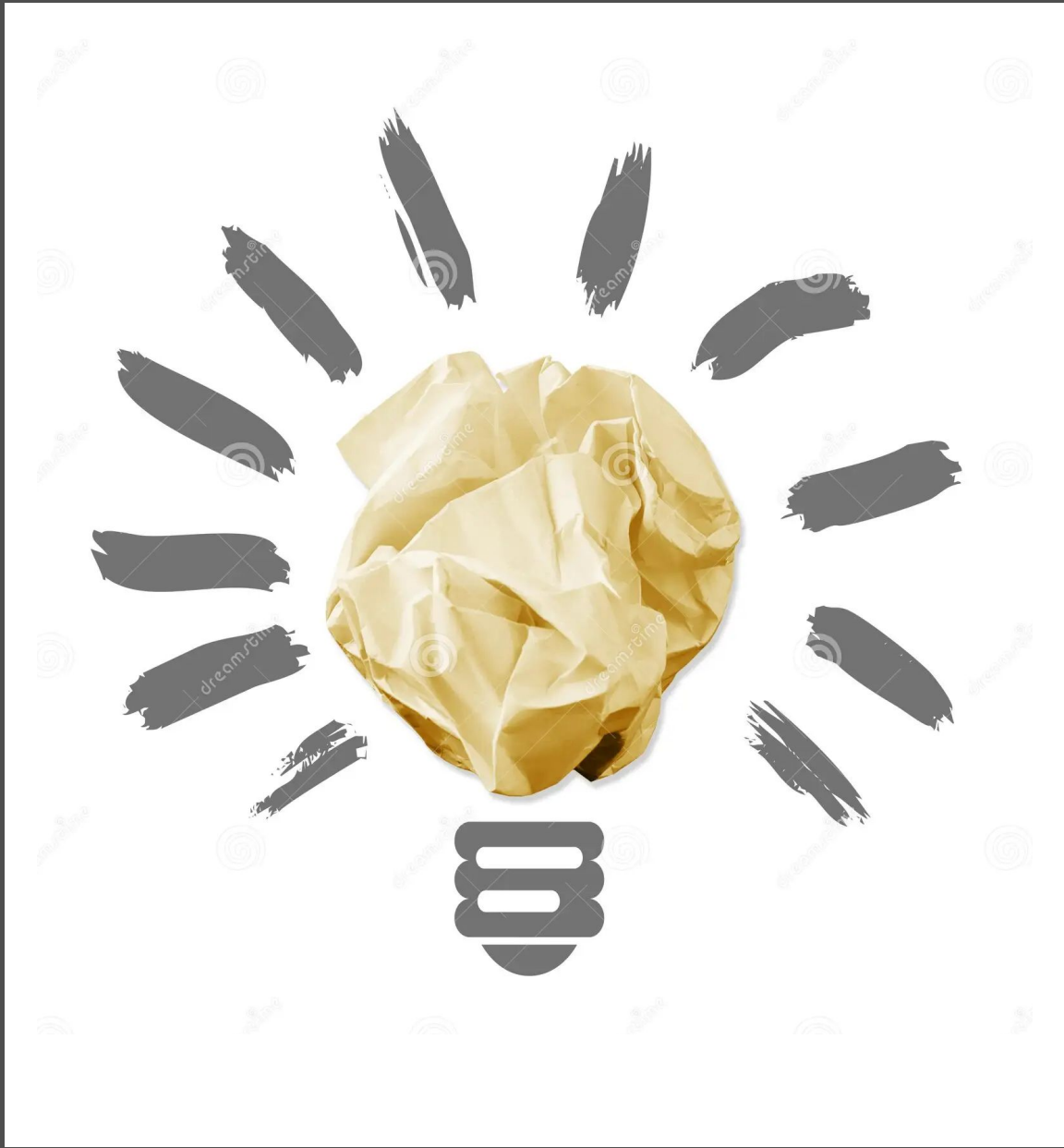
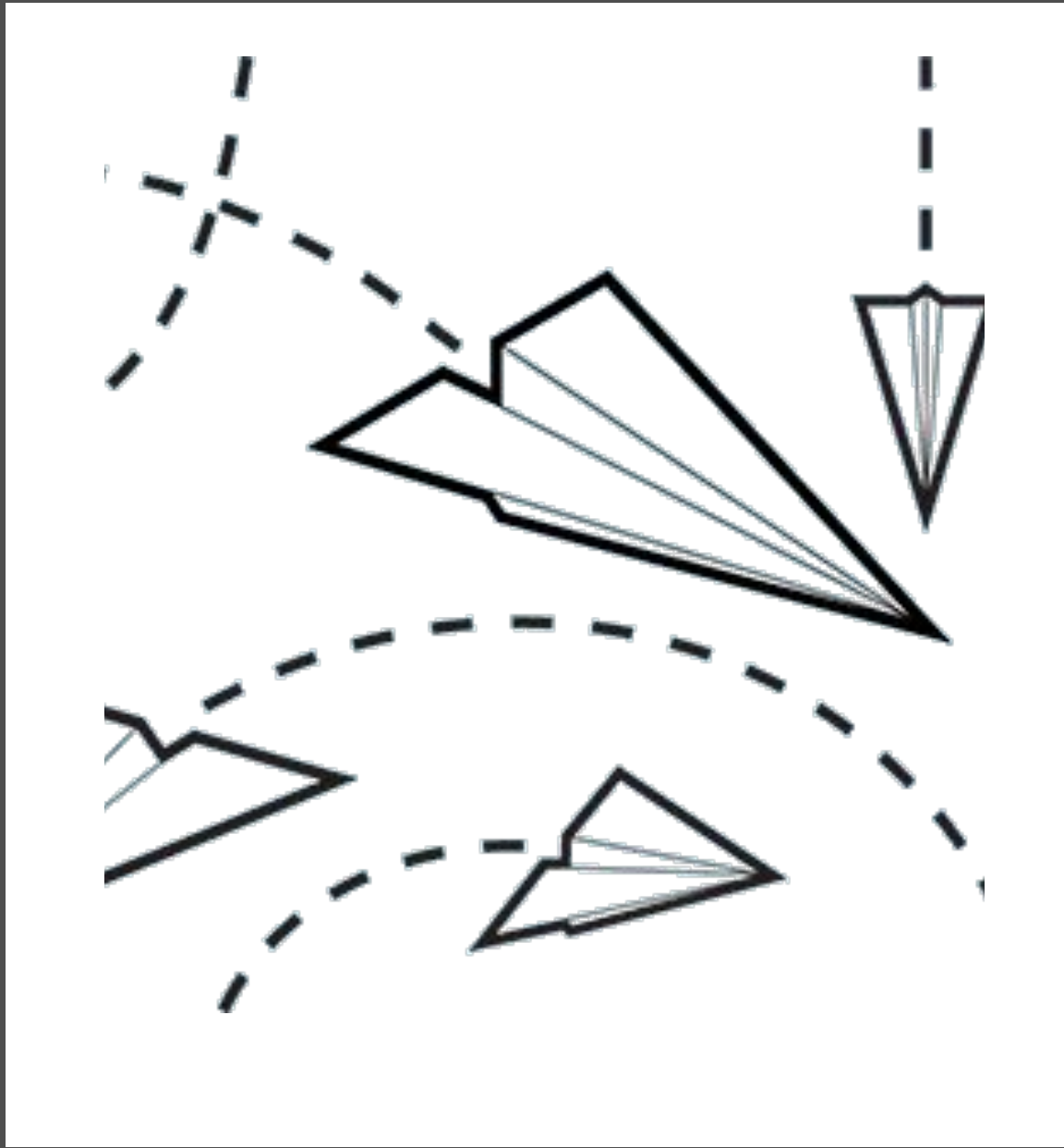
## What you may have missed...
