


#### **Setting the Stage**

## Challenges with Online Training









#### How it panned out

- Training sessions offered
- Registrations:
  - Summer/Fall 2020, webinars in July, August, Sept.
     Oct: 395
  - Did another round for K-12, 2 sessions in January 2021: 354



#### **Opportunities Created**

- Continued training with multiple schools and systems
- Developed short webinars for Donita's events
  - Brief intros to GALILEO (15 mins)—so POWERFUL!
  - eBooks



#### Tips, Tricks & Takeaways: Russell

- Collaboration is important
- Squeeze it in/make time if you can
- Brief is often better; short sessions create opportunities for extended interaction with K-12 media specialists
  - Follett Destiny integrations increased
  - GALILEO Local Resource Integration /Admin/customization involvement increased
  - GALILEO eBook collections were successfully promoted



## Tips/Tricks/Takeaways: Donita

- Decide if registration is necessary or if you want to simply share the meeting link
- Use a facilitator if possible
- Shut down other applications on your computer
- Turn off cameras if bandwidth is an issue
- Start with an icebreaker if there is time
- Make it interactive use polls, etc.



## Tips/Tricks/Takeaways: Donita

- ■Work with others collaboration is key!
- Utilize the expertise available (you don't have to know it all)
- People are eager to learn new things or better ways to do something
- Conversation can be more important than the instruction
- It doesn't have to be perfect...


